

## **PRE-EVENT TESTING (PET)**

## Who should obtain a negative result on a Pre-Event Test?

- Local attendees have not completed the full vaccination regimen
- Foreign attendees who are on a controlled Itinerary
- Any local residents and Business Travel Pass (BTP) holders with recent travel history. For the
  past 21 days, please refer to GoBusiness for more detail on Business Travel Pass (BTP):

## **Undergo Pre-Event Testing (PET):**

- The validity of a negative ART or PCR Test result is 24 hours from the time you register at the testing premises to take the test. Please take your COVID-19 test after 13:30 on 5 October the day before the event closing time 13:30, 6 October
- ART or PCR? We suggest that ART is generally more suitable for PET as ART usually has a much shorter turnaround time (around 30 minutes) compared to PCR tests (which may take up to 48 hours). A shorter turnaround time may mean you are able to get your result earlier in time to attend the event, if not, the result is no longer valid for the event by the time receiving.
- Refer to <u>a list of MOH-approved providers</u> for Antigen Rapid Testing (ATR). Self-administered
   ART supervised by employer and self-administered ART results are not recognised

## Acceptable documents for verification on the day of the event for onsite registration:

- 1. NRIC, FIN or Passport
- Updated TraceTogether App or an acceptable document issued by any clinics offering ART or PCR: Negative ART or PCR testing or PET Exemption Notice. Screenshots and pictures of the Acceptable Document are not acceptable for entry. PET status of the attendee is verified as part of SafeEntry check-in

Note: failure to bring either of these or a positive test result will result in a denial of entry into the venue
